India's aluminium scrap imports from US decline for the second straight month by 2% in Oct'22

India's aluminium scrap imports from the United States continued to decline in October 2022 by 2.39 per cent or 1,000 tonnes month-on-month to peg at 40,800 tonnes, found the US Census Bureau data. In September 2022, India's aluminium scrap import volume decreased by 9.33 per cent or 4,300 tonnes M-o-M from 46,100 tonnes to 41,800 tonnes. That indicated India's imports from the United States declined for the second month but at a slower rate.

The Flexible Packaging Association (FPA) says the US Department of Commerce (DOC) shouldn't be picking winners and losers in US manufacturing markets, but that is exactly what they are doing in the case of aluminum foil imports. A "self-initiated" case by the DOC against suppliers of aluminum foil from South Korea and Thailand threatens manufacturers of flexible packaging with unwarranted duties on necessary aluminum foil for food, pharmaceuticals, and medical device packaging.

Industry body Ficci has sought an increase in the import duty on aluminium and aluminium products to at least 12.5 per cent in the upcoming budget 2023-24, stating that the move will help curb dumping of aluminium products and encourage growth of the domestic manufacturing and recycling. The present import duty on aluminium and aluminium products is 10 per cent. Aluminium, a resilient metal that retains its fundamental properties even when recycled, is widely utilised.

China's aluminium imports record 26% slump in 2022 on sluggish consumption amid COVID-19

According to the recent data published by the General Administration of Customs released on Wednesday, January 18, China imported 2.39 million tonnes of unwrought aluminium and products, including primary metal and unwrought and alloyed aluminium. That reflected a year-on-year downfall of 25.6 per cent as domestic aluminium production increased to a record high and COVID-19 restrictions weighed on consumption.
