On February 9, 2026, the [London Metal Exchange \(LME\) aluminium prices](#) surged, reflecting a significant increase with declining inventory. The alumina platts tend to remain the same from the previous day's close. Both the LME cash bid and offer rose by USD 38.5 per tonne or 1.3 per cent, where the bid shifted from USD 3,044.5 per tonne to USD 3,083 per tonne and the offer from USD 3,045 per tonne to USD 3,083.5 per tonne.

[Europe's aluminium foil market decoded: Production and consumption drift apart, altering export-import balances](#)

The numbers tell a quiet but compelling story. Year after year, global [aluminium foil](#) consumption has moved steadily upward - not in bursts, but in a measured climb that signals durable, long-term demand that helps in aluminium market forecast. Back in 2018, worldwide aluminium foil usage was about 5.3 million tonnes. By 2023, that figure had climbed to 6.1 million tonnes. Current estimates place consumption at roughly 6.8 million tonnes in 2025, with volumes expected to move closer to 7 million tonnes in 2026.

Futures: Last Friday, SHFE aluminium night session closed at RMB 23,585 per tonne, up 0.98 per cent, fluctuating rangebound during the session. The price traded below the short-term moving averages, MA5 (23,610) and MA10 (24,118), under short-term pressure, but remained above the long-term MA60 (22,945.17), with the medium-term foundation intact. The MACD indicator's DIF (79.9094)

and DEA (278.9238) showed a high-level death cross, with the histogram deeply negative (-398.0288), indicating significant downward momentum.

New Delhi, Feb 9 (PTI) Aluminium prices on Monday rose nearly 0.71 per cent to Rs 318.75 per kg in futures trade as speculators built up fresh positions amid a positive trend in the spot market. On the Multi Commodity Exchange, aluminium for delivery in March increased by Rs 2.25, or 0.71 per cent, to Rs 318.75 per kilogram in 107 lots.

Analysts said fresh positions created by traders amid demand from consuming industries supported aluminium prices in the futures market.

In a recent interview in New Delhi, Union Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal discussed the back-pedal on the pending rebate on aluminium, steel, and copper. Earlier, a rebate was expected on the Indian exports of raw metals, but on the basis of the US national security duties defined in their Section 232 tariffs under the Trade Expansion Act of 1962, the tariffs remain at 50 per cent.

The company has been in protracted negotiations with the Southern African country's government and [power](#) suppliers for years to reach an agreement for the smelter's [energy](#)-intensive [operations](#).
